The celebrations begin with the recent release of the first indicator on the California School Dashboard. Last year, we launched an attendance campaign, *Every Student Every Day*. I am pleased to share that **our 2018 Chronic Absenteeism Rate has decreased by 1.2%.** These results only happen when communities work together. Thank you for making school a priority.

In addition, our academic growth continues to increase as evidenced by our most recent benchmark data. Our local assessments are demonstrating that students are gaining a deeper understanding of grade level content standards. Our efforts in making teaching and learning a priority by adopting new instructional materials and providing powerful professional learning and coaching for staff is making an impact on student achievement.

As I shared in the previous two months, we are also continuing to make social emotional learning a priority as we know that these academic achievements only happen when students, staff, and families feel connected to their school and district. This <u>video</u> provides a great overview for why this work is so important. Our Positive District Climate Committee met in November to begin researching additional resources to expand our multi-tiered system of support (MTSS). Our committee work will focus on the following three areas:

- Engagement- student participation in school; strong relationships between students, teachers, families & schools; and strong connections between schools & the broader community
- Safety- students, their families, and staff being free of violence, bullying, harassment, and controlled substance use, and schools being prepared in the event of an emergency
- Environment- appropriate learning settings, well-managed classrooms, available school-based physical and mental health supports, and clear, fair, disciplinary policies and practices

I am excited to work alongside our stakeholders and will continue to share outcomes from our committee as it evolves throughout the year.
